**Subject:** Moonlighting

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### **PURPOSE**

- To inform all residency and fellowship program trainees of moonlighting policies.

### **POLICY**

- Stony Brook Southampton Hospital prohibits all core residency a programs from permitting their residents to moonlight.
- ONMM 3 trainees may moonlight only under strict guidelines with permission of the Program Director and approval of the Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC). The ONMM 3 trainee must notify the program director of the location and nature of the proposed moonlighting activity and the number of hours the ONMM 3 trainee will work while moonlighting per week. The Program Director must submit this information, in writing, to the GMEC for approval. ONMM 3 trainees are not permitted to moonlight as physicians practicing the same specialty in which they are training. It is the responsibility of the ONMM 3 trainee to ensure that they maintain necessary licensure, certification, and malpractice coverage for moonlighting activities; these activities will not be covered under the policy which provides insurance for their activities in the training program.

Moonlighting must not interfere with the ability of the ONMM 3 trainee to achieve the goals and objectives of the educational program.

Time spent by ONMM 3 trainees moonlighting must be counted towards the 80 hour Maximum Weekly Hour Limit. These hours must be entered in New Innovations by the ONMM 3 trainee and tracked by the Program Director. Failure to do so will lead to revocation of the permission to moonlight.
