



Dear Applicant:

Stony Brook Southampton Hospital Volunteer Services appreciates your interest in becoming a volunteer. There are many areas in the Hospital, as well as our off-site facilities, that look forward to you assisting with the daily endeavors of supporting our organization and community. Listed below are the basic requirements you will need to know to start the volunteer application process:

- Junior Volunteers must be at least 15 years old and will have limited access to clinical areas.
- Adult Volunteers are required to be 18 years or older to volunteer within patient clinical areas.
- Adult Volunteer applicants 18 years and older will be required to pass a background check on completion of interview.
- All volunteers are to provide a current physical from their physician (included in the application), a copy of immunization records and your Covid-19 vaccine card with booster.
- All volunteers must meet with the Hospital's Employee Health Nurse to receive an initial PPD test and to receive medical clearance. Flu vaccine is required annually during flu season.
- All volunteers will receive a photo ID badge and uniform jacket to wear when volunteering.
- All volunteers must complete Hospital-wide Orientation prior to start of volunteering.
- All volunteers are required to donate a minimum of 3 hours per week.
- All volunteers are required to contact the Volunteer Director before their last day of service. Volunteers must return ID badge and jacket to volunteer office.

The Volunteer Director will contact you upon receipt of the application to set up an interview. If you have questions concerning the application process, please call the volunteer office at (631) 726-8336.
