Volunteer Services

Dear Applicant:

Stony Brook Southampton Hospital Volunteer Services appreciates your interest in becoming a volunteer. There are many areas in the Hospital, as well as our off-site facilities, that look forward to you assisting with the daily endeavors of supporting our organization and community. Listed below are the basic requirements you will need to know to start the volunteer application process:

- Junior Volunteers must be at least 15 years old.
- Adult Volunteers are required to be 18 years or older to volunteer within patient clinical areas.
- Adult Volunteer Ambassadors are required to be 18 years or older.
- Compassionate Care Program (NODA) Volunteers are required to be 21 years or older.
- Adult Volunteer applicants 18 years and older will be required to pass a background check on completion of interview.
- All volunteers are to provide a current physical from their physician, along with immunization records.
- All volunteers must meet with the Hospital's Employee Health Nurse to receive medical clearance. A PPD test is required annually.
- All volunteers will be issued a photo ID badge and uniform jacket to wear when volunteering.
- All volunteers must attend one **mandatory** Hospital-wide Orientation prior to start of volunteering. Orientations take place the first Tuesday of each month from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- All volunteers are required to donate a minimum of 3 hours per week.

Please return the completed application by mail, e-mail or fax to the Volunteer Department. The Volunteer Director will contact you upon receipt of the application to set up an interview.
